

BASIC JOB SAFETY TRAINING GUIDELINES

FELLER BUNCHER/PROCESSOR OPERATOR

- 1. Review company safety plan
- 2. Provide employee with a copy of Idaho Minimum Safety Standards for Logging to review job related rules.
- 3. Required safety apparel
 - Hard hat when out of machine
 - Hearing protection when necessary
- 4. Review hazardous communication and location of SDS sheets
- 5. First-Aid
 - First-Aid card current
 - First-Aid Kit location
 - Backboard location
- 6. Emergency rescue
 - Cell phone and/or radio operation
 - Job location
 - Who to contact (office/State Comm. 1-208-846-7610, 1-800-632-8000)
- 7. Review tag-out and energy control procedures
 - Follow manufacturer's suggestions when doing any maintenance (severe and fatal accidents have occurred while working on these types of machines).
- 8. Clear communication procedure
 - Go over with all employees working in area EXACTLY how to approach your machine
 - Go over safety concerns with skidding crew (skidding into landing or away from buncher)
 - Warn all loggers in the area of PINCH POINTS around machine
- 9. Make sure warning signs are visible to public
 - Flaggers may be necessary when falling trees along road ways.
- 10. Take precautions to avoid SLIPS and FALLS while doing maintenance and getting on and off the machine. (Injuries from simple slips and falls are becoming some of the most costly in our industry.)
