- 1. Review Company Accident Prevention Plan
- 2. Provide employee with a copy of Idaho Minimum Safety Standards for Logging to review job related rules.
 - Idaho Minimum Safety Standards for Logging (job related)
 - Company Accident Prevention Plan
 - Hazard Communication Plan (SDS sheet location)
- 3. Review:
 - Tag-Out Procedure
 - Emergency Evacuation
 - Blood-borne Pathogen Plan
 - Hazard Communication Program
- 4. Required Personal Safety Apparel when necessary:
 - Eye Protection
 - Hand Protection (chemicals and solvents)
 - Hearing (some cases)
- 5. Energy Control:
 - Blocking
 - Release Pressures
 - Lower Attachments
- 6. Replace guards and screen when repair is completed.
- 7. Review with operator any temporary repairs
- 8. Housekeeping in the shop and the field
- 9. Fire Prevention:
 - Check fire extinguishers monthly
 - Clear brush, slash, saw dust, oil, etc., before welding or cutting
- 10. Do not operate unfamiliar equipment until trained.
- 11. First-Aid
 - First-Aid card current
 - First-Aid kit locations
