Negotiated Rulemaking Minutes of 6/13/2022

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 PM MT by Dr. Chopski.

Dr. Chopski explained Executive Order 2020-1, regarding Zero Based Regulation (ZBR). This is a repeal and replace process to review all Board rules in the Division of Occupational and Professional Licenses (DOPL). Administrative Rule Chapter 24.34.01, Rules of the Board of Nursing were reviewed, specifically the changes to Rules that the Board has previously evaluated and is considering.

Dr. Chopski read a question from the public related to differentiating nursing specialties and titles, this question and all other public comments will be provided to the Board of Nursing.

Cynthia Dalsing, Region 1 representative from Nurse Practitioners of Idaho appeared telephonically to clarify the role of the Board of Nursing and the ZBR process. Dr. Chopski provided an overview of ZBR, which allows for a review of Administrative Rules to eliminate duplication and modernize outdated or overly complex language. She then explained the role the Board of Nursing plays in this process.

Ms. Dalsing relayed concerns about student preparation and difficulty finding clinical sites and preceptorships and the time involved with teaching while providing patient care, as preceptorships are part of nursing education. Dr. Chopski related that the Board of Nursing is analyzing Administrative Rule 600 regarding nursing education program accreditation.

Dr. Chopski summarized the following considerations of Administrative Rules:

60, 61 – the Board is reviewing the Continuing Education (CE) components.
76, 100, 101, 132, 315 – will be streamlined.
390, 400, 401, 402, 491, 460, 999 – will be discussed at the Board of Nursing Meeting on July 14, 2022.
600, 602, 700, 903 – have been reviewed at previous meetings and are set for revision.

Colleen Shackelford appeared telephonically, she had no additional comments and will continue to monitor the work of the Board.

The proposed Rule chapters will be available to the public on the Division of Occupational and Professional Licenses website.
