## **Negotiated Rulemaking Minutes of 8/10/2022**

The meeting was called to order at 4:05 PM MT by Dr. Chopski.

Dr. Chopski introduced herself and asked for questions from the virtual attendees before listing the chapters that have been reviewed by the Board.

Rule 390, Use of Titles, Abbreviations, and Designations for the Practice of Nursing, has been updated and streamlined to follow the Model Practice Act.

Rule 400, Decision-Making Model, is meaningful to the field of nursing and foundational to practice. The only language that was struck pertains to policies set forth by employers.

Rule 401, Licensed Registered Nurse (RN), strikes section 01. Standards of Practice which is duplicative of Statute. 02. Functions, strikes illustrative lists and will be placed in policy. Sections 03. and 04. are related to employment and will be set by employers.

Rule 402, Licensed Registered Nurse Functioning in Specialty Areas, has been condensed into one sentence.

Rule 460, Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN), will be structured in the same manner as 401 in policy.

Rule 491, Technicians/Technologists, will be moved to Rule 76 and are exempt from licensure.

Rule 999, is duplicative of Statutes 54-1411 and 54-1414 and was struck.

Dr. Chopski stated that the Idaho Board of Nursing reviewed 44 pages Administrative Rules in roughly six months and was the largest Rule chapter in Health Professions. The Board will revisit nurse apprentices and continuing education at their next meeting. There will be three more opportunities for public and stakeholder comment before the final draft will be completed.
