Approval of the January 27, 2022 Meeting Minutes

Board Business

<u>Proposed Legislation Development</u> – Mike Hatchet, TL Energy, presented the proposed advanced notification legislation. The Board agreed the topic does not belong in the Damage Prevention Board statutes.

<u>Executive Agency Legislation Process</u> – The Board has authority to promulgate rules. Deadline for suggestions is May 2022 for possible review at the 2023 legislature.

<u>Discuss Emergency Locates and Locate by Design</u> – Board Member Spears presented the redlines for Idaho Code § 55-2202 regarding emergency locates.

<u>Issues of Unlocatable Raceways for Future Use</u> – Board Member Ellis provided background on the issue.

<u>Utilities Getting Ahead of Established Build Timelines</u> – Contractors are claiming facility owners have stated certain areas will not have utilities until established timelines are determined. The contractor digs in these areas and find utilities installed. It was recommended for them to contact Digline for a locate ticket.
