SAFETY AND DISINFECTION RULES FOR RETAIL COSMETICS DEALER FACILITIES AND MAKEOVER OR GLAMOUR PHOTOGRAPHY BUSINESSES



CAKE, LOOSE OR LIQUID MAKEUP. Makeup that comes in a cake, loose or liquid form must be transferred to a palette with a disinfected or single-use spatula for use with a single patron and in a manner to prevent any contamination. Excess makeup on the palette must be disposed of immediately following use (Rule 200.04.a)

MAKEUP PENCILS. Makeup pencils that require a sharpener must be sharpened prior to each use. Sharpeners must be cleaned and disinfected in accordance with Rules 200.03.b. Eyeliner that does not require a sharpener must have a portion transferred to a palette with a disinfected or single-use spatula for use on a single customer (Rule 200.04.b)

MASCARA. Single-use applicators must be used in the application of mascara. (Rule 200.04.c)

BRUSHES AND IMPLEMENTS. Implements and applicators, including brushes, used on customers or made available for use by customers must be stored, cleaned, and disinfected or discarded in accordance with Rule 200.03.b and c. (Rule 200.04.d)

DISPLAYS. Makeup displays should be covered when not in use. When accessible for use by patrons, single-use applicators must be readily available (Rule 200.04.e)

WATER SUPPLY AND RESTROOM FACILITIES. The facility or business must meet the requirements in Rule 200.01.c

FIRST-AID KIT. Clearly identifiable first-aid kit must be readily accessible on the premises. The first aid kit shall contain the items set out in Rule 002.04. (Rule 200.04.f).

LICENSES AND CLASSIFICATION CARD. A current license/registration, a copy of these safety and disinfection rules, and a valid classification card must be conspicuously displayed in the work area of each facility. (Rule 200.04.g).
