

December 26th – Allocated tags become available for the 2024 season (excluding CH tags)

February 1st – Hunting Tag Use Verification Letters will be sent out

February 15th – Deadline to dispute historical tag use and submit hardship requests

February 29th – OGLB 1st quarterly board meeting of 2024

March 20th – IDFG Commission season setting for big game deer and elk

March 31st – End of Outfitter and Guide license year

Deadline to renew your license before it expires. Remember to submit your use reports before renewal as you will be unable to renew your license until you do so. Outfitters must also have a current certificate of liability.

April 10th – Allocated tag waiting list opens

April 20th – First day for tags to become available from the waiting list if any are available

May 1st – OGLB 2nd quarterly board meeting of 2024

July 1st – Launch of the new online licensing system OASIS

July 3rd – Allocated CH tags become available for the 2024 season

July 16th – Deadline to pick up allocated tags from IDFG (Unused tags revert to the undesignated tag pool for outfitters to claim from the waiting list, this excludes allocated CH tags)

July 24th – IDFG Commission sets allocation for 2025 limited general deer and un-capped elk hunts

July 31st – All unused allocated tags (excluding CH's) return to IDFG for sale to the general public

August 23rd – OGLB 3rd quarterly board meeting of 2024

September 10th – Deadline to pick up allocated CH tags from IDFG (Unused tags revert to the undesignated tag pool for outfitters to claim from the waiting list)

November 1st – Deadline to petition the Board to vacate from a stipulation for a hunt that has not occurred.

December 1st – Nonresident deer and elk tags go on sale (This excludes outfitter allocated tags)

December 20th – Deadline to report non-allocated tag use to IDFG
