The meeting was called to order at 5:00 PM by David McClusky, MD.

BOARD BUSINESS

Zero-Based Regulation (ZBR) Discussion: Dr. Chopski reviewed the fourth draft of the combined rule chapters, 24.33.01 and 24.33.03. Staff requested direction from the Board regarding the following draft rule changes:

001. Scope: The Board approved language moved to this rule that was present throughout the rule chapter.

- 010. Definitions: The Board reviewed the following definitions that were reworded and relocated from other areas in rule.
 - 01. Ablative: This definition was previously located in rule 164.01.
 - 05. Cosmetic Treatment: This definition was previously located in rule 164.01.
 - 06. Directing Physician: Part of this definition was struck and moved to 001. Scope.
 - 07. Incisive: This definition was previously located in rule 164.01.
 - 08. Medical Personnel: This definition was reworded to better align with the statutory definition of medical personnel.
 - 09. Parenteral Admixture: This definition was added as it was referenced in the amended rule 164.
 - 10. Prescriptive Medical/Cosmetic Device: This definition was previously located in rule 164.01.
 - 11. Prescriptive Medical/Cosmetic Product: This definition was previously located in rule 164.01.
 - 13. Supervising Physician of Medical Personnel: This definition was reworded for clarity.

011. Abbreviations. 06. FDA: This abbreviation was added as it is used throughout the rule chapter.

- <u>50.01.a.</u> Residence: The Board reviewed the new location of this rule under General Qualifications for Licensure.
- <u>051.01.</u> International Medical Graduate: The Board discussed and approved language to allow for an exemption for international physicians in alignment with House Bill 542.
- 164. Supervising Physicians of Medical Personnel: The Board discussed this rule as it relates to medical spas, Botulinum Toxin, IV hydration, and compounding GLP1s. The Board reviewed the draft language requested at their previous meeting to clarify who can perform procedures in these settings. Dr. Grajcar asked Mr. Spencer to reword a. Purpose, removing a list for consistency with the rest of the rule.
- <u>164.02.b.</u> Supervisory Responsibility: Board staff reviewed the placement of this rule and followed the Board's direction to move this rule under 164.01.d to maintain the original intent of the rule.
- <u>051. Onsite Review:</u> The board discussed the proper location for this rule and decided to move the rule under discipline.
- <u>080. Physician Panelist for Prelitigation Consideration of Medical Malpractice Claims:</u> The Board approved retitling this rule and 01. Eligibility to provide clarity.

A motion was made and seconded to adopt the draft rule chapter as proposed with the discussed changes. The motion carried.
