DIVISION BUSINESS

2018 Building and Energy Code Discussion: The Idaho Building Code (BLD) Board is currently going through Zero-Based Regulation (ZBR) and has asked Executive Officer Michael Hyde to contact the boards impacted as it pertains to the International Building Code, International Residential Code, and energy code. Manufacturers and stakeholders are encouraged to provide feedback to Mr. Hyde for the BLD Board to evaluate.

Zero-Based Regulation (ZBR) – **Review of the Rules:** This year, the Factory Built Structures Advisory Board is going through ZBR.
