Purpose: To provide clarity on the broad range of clinical patient care services pharmacists may offer in the State of Idaho independently or in collaboration with other healthcare professionals, the Board of Pharmacy offers the following guidance.

Policy:

Pharmaceutical care services may include but are not limited to:

- Performing drug product selection, substitution, medication administration, prescription adaptation, or refill authorization;
- Reviewing or formulating a drug utilization plan;
- Monitoring and evaluating the patient's response to drug therapy;
- Diagnosing the patient's health status or condition;
- Ordering and interpreting laboratory tests;
- Prescribing drugs and devices as provided in Idaho Code 54-1734; and
- Any other recognized clinical offering, not prohibited by Idaho Law, that falls within the education, training and experience of the licensed provider.

It is the responsibility of every pharmacist to ensure that the pharmaceutical care services they offer are within the acceptable standard of care.
