DIVISION BUSINESS

Financial Report: Executive Officer (EO) MiChell Bird presented the Fiscal Year 2026, Quarter 2 Financial Report. The Division is presenting the fee increase to the 2026 Legislative Session pursuant to [Idaho Code § 67-2608](#).

Respectful Workplace Training: The 2026 Respectful Workplace Training was provided.

BOARD BUSINESS

Legislative Update: The Division is presenting an Executive Agency Legislation on Universal Discipline to the 2026 legislative session. EO Bird noted that the draft legislation by the Idaho Home Builders Association had not yet been presented but that she will continue to monitor and provide updates to the Board on any legislation that may affect the industry.

Contractor/Consumer Education: The Division is currently developing educational resources for both Consumers and Contractors. Drafts will be presented at the next meeting.
