The meeting was called to order at 8:35 AM by Kris Jonas, PharmD.

Approval of Minutes: A motion was made and seconded to approve the 08/15/2025 minutes. The motion carried.

DIVISION BUSINESS

FDA and National Updates Review: The Committee reviewed several articles from the Federal Drug Administration regarding illegal importation of lifestyle injectable drugs; compounding; illegal marketing and unapproved GLP-1 drugs. The Committee reviewed a synopsis of new guidance's that the FDA has recently published.

Review of Compounding Statutes: The Committee reviewed the Idaho Board of Pharmacy practice act and Idaho Code 54-1765 Compounding; 54-1766 Sterile Compounding; and 54-1767 Hazardous Drugs.

Review of 3rd Party Med Spa Proposal: Lisa Zimmerly med-spa owner and licensee with the Board of Barbers & Cosmetology gave a presentation that she would like the association to present to the upcoming legislation in establishing a Board of Medical Aesthetics and the importance of regulation with the Boards of Medicine, Nursing, Dentistry and Cosmetology. The presentation explained the oversight of cosmetic treatments such as dermal fillers, laser therapies and microneedling is currently fragmented between the boards and has resulted in confusion and inconsistencies in enforcement.

Notice of Unlicensed Dispensing: The Committee reviewed a Notice Regarding Dispensing Medication warning letter and provided feedback. A motion was made and seconded to approve the Notice with edits as discussed. The motion carried.

Patient Education Flyer: A motion was made and seconded to accept the patient education flyer. The motion carried.

Disciplinary Matrix Review: The Committee reviewed the disciplinary matrix and provided suggestions.

Public Comment: Bobbie Bullock stated that there needs to be a national standard in place.

EXECUTIVE SESSION
