**Approval of 02/09/2026 Minutes:**

A motion was made and seconded to approve the February 9, 2026, meeting minutes. The motion carried unanimously.

**DIVISION BUSINESS**

**Financial Report:** The Fiscal Year (FY) 2026, Quarter (Q) 2 Financial Report was reviewed at the February 9, 2026, meeting. The next financial report will be generated after the completion of FY 2026, Q3 and will be provided at the next meeting.

**BOARD BUSINESS**

**Legislative Update:** Executive Officer Michelle Bird provided updates on the 2026 Legislative Session for [House Bill 768](#) relating to the Contractors Registration Act, [House Bill 703](#) relating to the Universal Division Discipline Procedure, and [Docket number 24-2101-2501](#) relating to the Rules of the Idaho Contractors Board (Fee Rule). In 2025, per the [Idaho Code Cleanup Act](#), DOPL conducted a comprehensive review of statutes to identify any obsolete, outdated, or unnecessary language and a report was submitted to the Governor's Office. Legislation based on the report was expected to be drafted by the Governor's office but was not introduced during the 2026 Legislative Session.

**Contractor Education:** Education and Training Specialist Jeannien DeWitt presented the draft Contractor Education guidance document which included sections detailing the requirements to attain, the jobs and acts that are exempt from, and the benefits of having a General Contractor registration. An updated draft with the discussed changes will be provided at the next meeting.

**Public Comment:** There were no public comments.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION – APPLICATION(S) & DISCIPLINE:**

A motion was made and seconded that the board enter Executive Session under Idaho Code § 74-206(1)(d) to consider records that are exempt from disclosure under the Public Records Act, Idaho Code § 74-106(9). The purpose of the Executive Session will be to discuss documents relating to the fitness of an applicant to be granted a registration or retain a registration.
