Discipline Guidelines

The Outfitters and Guides Licensing Board is authorized by Title 36, Chapter 21, Idaho Code, to discipline license holders for violations of the Board’s laws and/or rules. The specific grounds for discipline from Idaho Code §36-2113 are listed below, along with the guidelines for administrative penalties that may be applied to various conduct. The Board is authorized to impose a \$5,000 fine for each violation. The Board may impose additional disciplinary sanctions and recover costs incurred in the investigation and prosecution of violations of the Outfitters and Guides Act.
