The meeting was called to order at 8:31 AM by Ms. Lotridge.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A motion was made and seconded to approve the 04/23/2026 minutes. The motion carried.

DIVISION BUSINESS

Committee Training-Open Meeting Law: Mr. Loos presented information regarding open meeting law requirements.

Legislative Update: Mr. Duffin presented a brief overview of HB703 regarding Universal Discipline. Mr. Loos then covered that the tools provided in HB703 support uniformity across all Boards, including alignment of enforcement actions such as licensure revocations, fines, and restitution hearings. He stated the bill will assist in uniform compliance with statutory requirements. Staff then addressed questions and comments from Committee members.

COMMITTEE BUSINESS

Committee Elections: A motion was made and seconded to elect Dr. Sutherland as Committee Chair, and Dr. McClusky as Vice-Chair. The motion carried.

EXECUTIVE SESSION:

A motion was made and seconded to exit Executive Session. The motion carried.

DISCIPLINE:

A motion was made and seconded to recommend that the Board of Medicine close case numbers: 1910013; 1955580; 1957149; 1974221; 1978071; 1985224; 1993450; 1994590; 1996402; 1999016; 2006517; 2006518; 2007632; 2010393; 2022939; and 2025411. The motion carried.

A motion was made and seconded to recommend that the Board of Medicine close with a Letter of Concern case numbers: 1969627; 1993451; 2022696. The motion carried.

A motion was made and seconded to recommend that the Board of Medicine authorize negotiation of an Agreement in Lieu of Discipline with the terms discussed in executive session and authorize legal counsel to approve on behalf of the Board regarding case numbers: 1980482; and 2053338. The motion carried.
