The meeting was called to order at 8:30 AM MT by Ms. Garner.

Approval of Minutes

A motion was made and seconded to approve the 06/24/2026 minutes. The motion carried.

DIVISION BUSINESS

Board Training – Public Member: The Board decided to defer this training until a public member is appointed to the Committee.

Board Training – Universal Discipline: Ms. Beller provided an overview of House Bill 703 and Idaho Code § 67-2616, which created a universal discipline framework for DOPL-administered boards, effective July 1, 2026.

COMMITTEE BUSINESS

APRN Policies Recommendation Review: Ms. Edwards presented the Committee with an opportunity to review and amend the two current nursing policies specific to APRN practice: “Peer Review – APRN” and “Re-Entry to Practice – APRN.” A motion was made and seconded to approve the two policy recommendations as written. The motion carried.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

A motion was made and seconded to enter Executive Session pursuant to Idaho Code § 74-206(1)(d) to consider records that are exempt from public disclosure pursuant to Idaho Code § 74-106(9). The purpose of the executive session was to discuss documents relating to the fitness of a licensee to retain a license. The vote was: Ms. Reusser, aye; Ms. Schoenecker, aye; Ms. Peppersack, aye; and Ms. Garner, aye. The motion carried.

A motion was made and seconded to exit Executive Session. The motion carried.

COMMITTEE DISCIPLINE

A motion was made and seconded to recommend that the Board of Nursing close case numbers: 2031154 and 2045702. The motion carried.

A motion was made and seconded to recommend that the Board of Nursing close with a Letter of Concern case number 2099373. The motion carried.

A motion was made and seconded to recommend that the Board of Nursing authorize negotiation of an Agreement in Lieu of Discipline with the terms discussed in executive session and authorize legal counsel to approve on behalf of the Board regarding case numbers: 2091893 and 2127794. The motion carried.

A motion was made and seconded to recommend that the Board of Nursing enter a Stipulation and Consent order regarding case number 2031928. The motion carried.
